StarkAge 5P announces the start of its commercial activities, launches its website, and convenes its advisory committees

- First part of its website, information platform on aging intended for the general public, now online
- Setup of a “Mission” Committee responsible for advising the management team on the StarkAge 5P strategy and its development
- Setup of a Scientific Advisory Committee to validate the scientific work on aging and the specific approach proposed
- StarkAge 5P founded by Dr. Thierry Mathieu has already been joined by 2 future investors

Lille, France, June 21st, 2022 – StarkAge 5P is a “Société à Mission ” whose raison d’être is to extend healthy lifespan. Its mission is to make proven and up-to-date scientific and medical information accessible to the general public, while having a the deep understanding of aging. Its second mission is to offer innovative solutions based on genomic biology to fight against the onset of age-related diseases, early dependence, and loss of autonomy.

StarkAge 5P has just released its information platform with already many videos, interviews and documents explaining the root causes of aging and how to mitigate them. This is the first phase of its website, which will become the reference platform on longevity.

Aware of the social and societal issues, but also of the scientific challenges inherent in its activities, StarkAge 5P has surrounded itself with two advisory committees responsible for guiding its strategic thinking and the development of the company: a “Mission” Committee with **Luc Ferry**, philosopher , former minister and **Nicolas Bouzou**, economist, but also a Scientific Committee. These two committees have been brought together for a first founding meeting which marks the launch of StarkAge 5P.

StarkAge 5P offers the most innovative solutions adapted to each person's individual metabolism thanks to its offers of personalized medicine consultations (medicine and genomic biology) which allow an anti-aging preventive action perfectly fitting each person.

About the Mission Committee

The Mission Committee ensures compliance with the moral values of the company and participates in the definition of its strategic orientations. He advises the management team on the overall strategy, development, and action plan in relation to our "Raison d'être" and our Missions, discusses the ramifications, societal changes and trends relating to longevity, in connection with the legitimate role of StarkAge 5P and will help develop and maintain an ethical charter.

Its current members are:

- **Nicolas Bouzou**: Liberal economist, essayist, director of studies and teacher at the University of Paris II Assas. Member of the Council for analysis of society to the Prime Minister (2010-12). Vice-President of the Turgot circle. Founded the consulting firm Asterès
- **Pr. Luc Ferry**: Professor of philosophy, essayist and French politician. He was Minister of Youth, National Education and Research from 2002-04.

About the Scientific Advisory Committee

The Scientific Committee is responsible for providing advice on StarkAge 5P scientific projects. Participate in the development of StarkAge 5P scientific policy, including reviewing and discussing scientific innovations and technology trends relevant to StarkAge 5P, discussing the scientific and medical validity of the StarkAge 5P Genomic Longevity Pathway, algorithms for determining its biological age, participating in the implementation of clinical trials, scientific studies, publications, etc.

It includes :

- **Pr. Philippe Froguel MD, PhD**: Endocrinologist and researcher. Professor and Chair of Genomic Medicine at Imperial College London. Professor of endocrinology at the University Hospital of Lille and Director of EGID.
- **Dr. Jean-Michel Lecerf MD, PhD**: Medical Doctor specializing in nutrition, endocrinology and metabolic disorders. In 1982, he created the nutrition service at the Lille Institut Pasteur in Lille. He is medical director of the Longevity Health Prevention Center of the Lille Institut Pasteur.
- **Pr. Xavier NASSIF MD, PhD**: Medical Doctor and research professor in microbiology. General Manager of the Lille Institut Pasteur, and co-head of the “Pathogeny of systemic infections” team of the Clinical Microbiology department of the Necker-Enfants Malades Hospital.
- **Pr. Pascal Pujol MD, PhD**: Medical geneticist specializing in oncology. He is Professor at the Faculty of Medicine of Montpellier University, and Head of the Oncogenetics Department of the Montpellier University Hospital. He is president of the French Society of Predictive and Personalized Medicine.

StarkAge 5P has a unique offer: a complete ecosystem for the prevention of aging and age-related diseases with personalized medicine specialists, an international network of biology laboratories and medical support to fight against frailties, or risk factors.

The goal of StarkAge 5P is to prevent age-related diseases and extend healthy longevity through three levers:
